To amend title 18, United States Code, to increase the penalty for rioting.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Mitigating Extreme5 Lawlessness and Threats Act".

6 SEC. 2. RIOTS.

7 Section 2101 of title 18, United States Code, is8 amended—

9 (1) in subsection (a), in the flush text following
10 paragraph (4), by striking "subparagraph (A), (B),
11 (C), or (D)" and all that follows and inserting
