

Motion to Commit With Instructions

_____ moves to commit the bill H.R. 5376 to the Committee on the Judiciary of the Senate with instructions to report the same back to the Senate in 3 days, not counting any day in which the Senate is not in session, with changes that—

1 (1) are within the jurisdiction of such com-
2 mittee; and

3 (2) would increase spending to reduce the avail-
4 ability of illicit fentanyl analogues, which may in-
5 clude changes to the scheduling of fentanyl ana-
6 logues, such as making permanent the scheduling
7 actions of the Drug Enforcement Administration re-
8 lating to fentanyl analogues.
